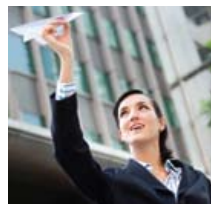
Attending on behalf of Aventure was Senior Director of Sales Melissa Coleman and Commercial Sales Account Manager Jordan Yohr.
