Boeing 767-300ER Purchased for Teardown



Aventure Aviation recently purchased a Boeing 767-300ER (MSN 24952) from the Bank of Utah and AeroTurbine, Inc. The aircraft was dismantled for parts at AeroTurbine's facility in Goodyear, Arizona, USA.

"This acquisition considerably expands Aventure's inventory of Boeing material and service capabilities," said Melissa Coleman-Grina, Senior Director of Sales.

With close to 1,000 Boeing 767 planes in worldwide service, the company is poised to provide increased spares support for 767 and 757 fleets, since several parts are common to both models.

"Our staff is ready to serve customers with parts in 'as removed', 'fresh serviceable', or 'fresh overhaul' condition on an exchange or outright sales basis," said Zaheer Faruqi, Aventure's President. "This project gives us the opportunity to increase our service to the Boeing community."
