## Aventure Exhibits at MRO Americas in Miami Beach

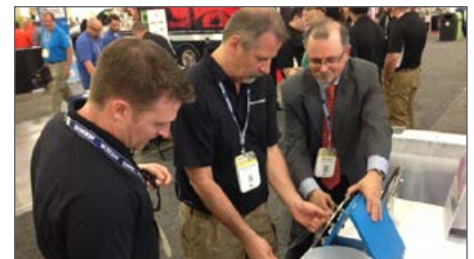
